



CONSENT FORM

Parent, Guardian, or Caretaker Consent Form for Participation in the **#FARBENBEKENNEN AWARD 2021** Competition

Because the competition is open to children and young people aged 8 to 16, this consent form must be signed by the legal guardian and submitted with the minor's (someone who is not yet 18 years old) application. If the consent form is not submitted, the minor in question will not be able to take part in the competition.

to take part in the competition for the #FARBENBEKENNEN AWARD 2021 in accordance with the eligibility requirements.

If the child is nominated for the award, I/we also consent to my/our child or ward taking part in a photo and/or video shoot and appearing in photos and/or videos that will be put on the Internet and included in printed advertising/brochures as part of the accompanying publicity campaign. In particular, this applies to:

- Permanent display on the #FARBENBEKENNEN website www.farbenbekennen.de
- During the voting period on the following channels: social media (Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, Tik Tok), in print advertising (posters, Berlin newspapers), online advertising (newsletters, banner ads), and outdoor advertising. The nominees and the work they have done are highlighted on these channels, and the people of the city are invited to vote for their favorite nominee.

To the extent that the photos and/or videos give an indication of the child's ethnic origin, religion, or health (e.g., skin color, head covering, glasses), my/our consent also applies to this.

I am/We are aware that information on the Internet is accessible worldwide and can be found with search engines and connected to other information, which means that in some circumstances it may be possible to put together a profile of my/our child. Information put on the Internet, including photos and videos, can be easily copied and shared. There are special archiving services that aim to permanently document the state of certain websites at certain points in time. As a result, information published on the Internet may still be found elsewhere even after it has been deleted from the original website.



The photos submitted by the participants with their application must be free of claims and/or rights of third parties. Submitting photos that glorify violence, are racist, or violate the law is prohibited. There is no entitlement to publication of the photos.

If the minor for whom you are the legal guardian should win any prize money, the money cannot be used for private purposes. Rather, it must be used in its entirety for the common good in connection with the work for which the award winner was nominated (for instance, for the initiative in which the award winner is involved).

This consent is voluntary. I have the right to refuse to give my consent without giving a reason, and I will suffer no negative consequences from such refusal. However, the minor in question will then not be able to participate in the #FARBENBEKENNEN AWARD competition.

I/We can also revoke this consent at any time in writing (e.g., in a letter or email) (the revocation of consent by one parent or legal guardian will suffice even if both parents signed the consent form). Photos in which my/our child is recognizable and that focus primarily on my/our child (for instance, while on the phone or engaging in some typical activity) will then be removed from websites connected to the Senate Chancellery (including www.farbenbekennen.de) without delay and will no longer be used for new printed materials. If my/our child is pictured in a photo with other people, the photo does not have to be removed. Rather, it shall suffice if the image of my/our child is promptly pixelated or otherwise made unrecognizable.
